CHAMPIONING OUR CHILDREN

INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUNDS

Both **Alex and Rvan** believe that all children have a right to play and that this should be reflected in the community play spaces. Playgrounds are important spaces for community engagement and childhood development and should be built with inclusivity as a core principle.

To do this we must ensure that when playgrounds are improved they must include

accessible design and inclusive equipment that disabled children can use and play on.

Research from Scope has discovered that 96% of parents with disabled children had used a public playground in the past year - but 49% said they had accessibility problems with these playgrounds.

To make sure play equipment in our ward and Weymouth as a whole is inclusive and accessible to all, Ryan put a motion through Weymouth Town Council in November which was passed and will ensure the principles of inclusive design are included going forward in every development or refurbishment of a council playground.



TACKLING CHILD POVERTY

In 2017 the Conservative Government introduced a cruel rule that restricted support in Universal Credit and tax credits to two children per household. End Child Poverty Coalition figures suggest that there could be >5500 children whose families are affected in Dorset (approx

8% of children). Local child poverty rates for Dorset are running at 25%. Scrapping the two child limit would be one of the most effective ways of reducing child poverty.

Lib Dems are the only party to have consistently opposed this policy. Leader Cllr Nick Ireland successfully put forward a motion that Dorset Council should continue to put pressure on the Government to scrap the two child limit. Ryan commented, 'This government has no idea what it is like for our residents. Having more than two children is not a crime and larger families should not be singled out for this treatment.'

BENCHES ON THE MARSH



Ryan and Alex were pleased after long campaigning that they were able to get these new benches on the marsh following multiple requests from residents who used to sit on the stone borders prior to the installation of the fences as part of the

actions taken to protect the Marsh from illegal encampments.

They both look forward to sitting and chatting to other residents in the warmer weather while out walking their dogs, Rocket and Barker, familiar to many local people, and while their children are playing in the park.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Gill has been championing housing for local people for a long time and has now secured some Dorset Council funding to help with this.

Gill commented 'It is crazy that the Conservatives at Dorset Council say they are committed to affordable housing and yet they provide little funding for it. I put forward an amendment at Full Council which put £4M a year into a pot for this. This may not seem much when talking



about housing but if it is used well it will go a long way and hopefully when the Conservatives are out of office in May we can add to it.'



2024/5 COUNCIL TAXES

WEYMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL remains unchanged while DORSET COUNCIL increase theirs yet again



Dorset Council have just set your council tax for 2024/5. Their share has gone up by 5% meaning that you will be paying one of the highest council tax rates in the country. To add to this last year there was £2M put aside to help residents with the cost of living. This has been removed so there will not be so much grant funding available to help hard pressed families.

CHRISTMAS SLEIGH COLLECTION




